MAIN TOPICS AND DEBATE TABLES

BLOCK 1: School nurses' competence role.

In this block, oral presentations and posters have as an objective to show the different roles that nurses have in schools around the world.

BLOCK 2: Children and adolescents with special needs.

This block includes how school nurses organize their tasks in schools with children who need daily healthcare or special care related to a disability or other pathologies, as well as the specific guidelines to be followed.

BLOCK 3: Health education and promotion.

To get familiar with different health promotion programmes and those micro-programmes carried in schools:

- Educational proposals in schools.
- Take care of students' health needs through health education.
- School for parents.
- Risks and illnesses prevention at school.
- Health promotion teaching methodologies.
- New technologies applied to health education.
- Diverse proposals and ideas.

BLOCK 4: School research.

To learn about research works related to healthcare at school, as well as publications in this regard. Proposals for research projects that have been or are being carried out in any country.

Publication of Doctoral and Master's theses.

We include in this section the work and experiences by different associations that work on nursing and school health.

MAIN TOPICS AND DEBATE TABLES

BLOCK 5: Students' health records.

To identify the link between school nurses and other health professionals; to know the guidelines they follow, jargon, assessments and nursing diagnoses that they carry out to keep a record of healthcare and health promotion in schools around the world.

* Proposals for health records are accepted.

BLOCK 6: School nurses training.

This block focuses on sharing information about the different training courses and special programmes in healthcare for children and adolescents in schools. Besides, knowing the specific requirements and educational needs nurses look for and are interested in, in order to keep expanding their knowledge and preparation in health education.

BLOCK 7: Healthcare during pandemic times.

To present guidelines, action plans or health interventions that have been or are being carried out in schools due to the pandemic situation.

BLOCK 8: Miscellaneous.

Any topic related to children and adolescents' physical, emotional and mental health, that haven't been covered in other blocks.

ABSTRACT PRESENTATION

All abstracts must follow the next characteristics:

- Title.
- Main author (the person in charge of the oral or poster presentation).
- Contributing authors (no more than 5, including the main author. All of the authors must be registered).
- Email.

Format:

- 250 words max.
- Introduction, objectives, methodology, results and conclusions.
- Specify the presentation format (poster or oral presentation) by email.
- Language: can be presented in Spanish, English or French.
- **Recommendation:** *power points* could be in a different language from the one used during the oral presentation (preferably Spanish or English).

Submission deadline:

- Before October 20, 2021.

- The Scientific Committee will select 20 oral presentations to be presented during the Symposium.

ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- Authors of the abstracts selected will get notified between October 20 and 24, 2021.
- Posters: must be presented in the assigned template provided by the Organizing Committee.
- Oral presentations: will be presented in a 10 min. video.
- The Oral presentations selected for the Symposium must be presented preferably in English. However, they can be presented in Spanish or French if the videos have English subtitles or if the power point being presented is in English.
- All Oral presentations and posters must be presented along a power point (it is not mandatory to use it during the presentation but, to be used as visual support).

ORAL PRESENTATIONS BOOK

Authors who present a poster or oral presentation and are interested in getting their work published in this book, can submit an article that must meet the following requirements:

- 1750 to 2500 words maximum (including the references).
- Title, authors and email.
- Font: Time New Roman.
- Language: English, Spanish or French

You can submit your paper from July 30 until September 30, 2021.

AWARDS

International Nurse Smile Award National School Nurse Award Best Oral and Poster presentation Award

- School nurse's trajectory award, to recognise their experience, research work, contribution and their fight for school nursing.
- The nomination of candidates should be presented by an educational centre, association, university or social entity.
- Present a memory of the candidate's trajectory in no more than 500 words.
- A jury will evaluate and announce the winners for each category.
- The jury will award three oral presentations and three poster presentations, at a national and international level.
